Scaramouche was a clown character in Italian comic theater and literature dating back to the 1600s. Scaramouche was usually presented as a vain buffoon who behaves flamboyantly and eventually loses his head. The Scaramouche on the left depicts the role as played by the 19th century English actor, J.S. Grimaldi. The Scaramouche on the right is taken from the animated television series, Samurai Jack, which ran on Cartoon Network for five seasons. In the animated series, Scaramouche is a robotic assassin. Scaramouche also 'does the Fandango' in Queen's Bohemian Rhapsody.
